_____ Read and sign terms of agreement

_____ Two to three letters of recommendation. Reference letters **must be attached to** your application and may be obtained from teachers, employers, clergy, youth group leaders, etc.

_____ Attach all High School and/or Community College/University transcripts. (Academic Scholarship applications – **required**; Vocational and Fine Arts Scholarship applications – **optional**.)

ELIGIBILITY: CCRC scholarships are awarded to residents of CCRC-funded affordable housing projects. Applicants must be high school seniors and adult residents pursuing a higher education. Applicants for academic, vocational, and fine arts scholarships must be high school seniors with a GPA of 2.0 or better and eligible for admission in September 2010-11 to a community college, university or fine arts school program indicated on the scholarship application.

SPECIAL NOTE: Scholarships must be used within 18 months of the award date. In most cases, checks will be made payable to the educational institution; however, we will try to make other arrangements if the award results in the loss of other financial aid.
